Better Usability

- › Intelligent Installation: The Installation Wizard detects the localized folder name and updates the respective configuration files.
- › Informative and suggestive messaging: Detailed instructions and error messages are now provided for easier troubleshooting.
- › Built-in comprehensive user guide.
- › New web parts for easier access to information and to provide a rich user experience.
- › Enhanced organization chart: More user-friendly tree view and additional options to include the designation and department of each resource represented in the chart.



Easier Administration

- › Document Recovery: Allows users to recover deleted documents.
- › Test emails to check email server settings.
- › Provision to remove accelerator (without deleting SWA Content database).
- › Switch between SPS and Active Directory resource handlers: Allows the resource handler to be switched between SPS and Active Directory by selecting the appropriate option in the Virtual Server Settings Configuration.

- › Launch Admin Console without leaving Central Administration.
- › Stringent privilege checks on Manage Admin Account providing enhanced security.
- › End-user confirmation for modifying SharePoint database schema to minimize the risk of accidental changes.
- › Native identification of SharePoint MSDE default instance and adaptive behavior: Lists without triggers will no longer be displayed in the Documents and Lists list of Assign Workflows, if an MSDE database is installed as the content database .
- › Provision to add Active Directory attributes manually: Enables faster configuration of the Active Directory.



Closer Integration with Microsoft SharePoint

- › New SharePoint Portal Server Actions.
- › New Audience Resource Filter for SharePoint Portal Server: Allows actions to be assigned to audience groups in SharePoint portals.
- › New Actions for both Windows SharePoint Services and SharePoint Portal Server.



Improved Process Administration

- › New Debug Tools.
- › Views of sites associated with document library / list for a given workflow: Facilitates simultaneous removal of workflows assigned to multiple sites.
- › Support for HTTPS (SSL) enabled sites.
- › Support for workflow execution on picture libraries .
- › Separate display of SharePoint sites with errors to provide greater clarity .
- › Revamped process definition management: Enhances usability with a redesigned user-interface and streamlined functionality.



Enhanced Workflow Execution

- › Workflow execution on Generic Lists and task lists:
 - › Support for workflow execution from remote SPS database.
 - › SWA Listener setup to install the remote call mechanism on all SharePoint content database servers.
 - › A web service to accept remote calls on SharePoint Accelerator server.
- › Logging of relevant content by SharePoint actions: New Report functionality enables all SharePoint actions to log relevant content in the Reporting control.



Improved Process Designer

- › Support for all new Skelta Workflow.NET 2004 R2 actions such as Work and Choice.
- › Provision to open a workflow process design in Read Only mode: Helps to protect the process design from accidental changes that could otherwise occur when the design is opened for viewing in Edit mode.
